MetaMap's XML Output

When called with one of the options `--XMLf`, `--XMLn`, `--XMLf1`, or `--XMLn1`, MetaMap generates XML output:

- `--XMLf` generates formatted XML containing one XML document for each input *record*.
Input records are by default separated by a blank line.
The formatted XML output generated from the input `heart attack` can be viewed [here](#).
- `--XMLn` generates unformatted XML containing one XML document for each input *record*.
Input records are by default separated by a blank line.
The unformatted XML output generated from the input `heart attack` can be viewed [here](#).
- `--XMLf1` generates formatted XML containing one XML document for each input *file*.
- `--XMLn1` generates unformatted XML containing one XML document for each input *file*.
